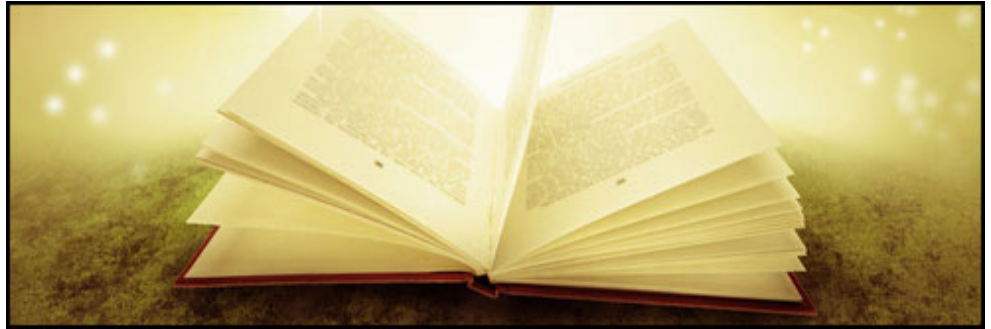

CAN GOD COUNT ON YOU?



ONE BODY WITH MANY MEMBERS

For as the body is one and has many members, but all the members of that one body, being many, are one body, so also is Christ. For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body – whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free – and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.” 1 Corinthians 12:12-13.

When Jesus finished His time on earth, He sent His Spirit back to the disciples so that they could have power to overcome sin in the way that Jesus did while He was on earth. It was Jesus' intention not only to create a way back to the Father, but also to make it possible that we could follow Him. Because He made this way back to God, He is the Head of the body. But God is also forming a body on earth of people who are going the same way that Jesus went. The members of this body are extremely diverse – from every corner of the earth. There are no earthly qualifications needed to belong to this body – only a love for Jesus that drives me to follow Him on the way of the cross.

“For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another. Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, let us use them ...” Romans 12:4-6.

Each part of the body is not the same and each part performs a different function. But Paul clearly explains here that each part is equally important so that the body can function in harmony. This means that no matter what my age, gender, nationality, circumstances, or personality, I am a vital member of the body of Christ if I am following Him on the way of sanctification!
