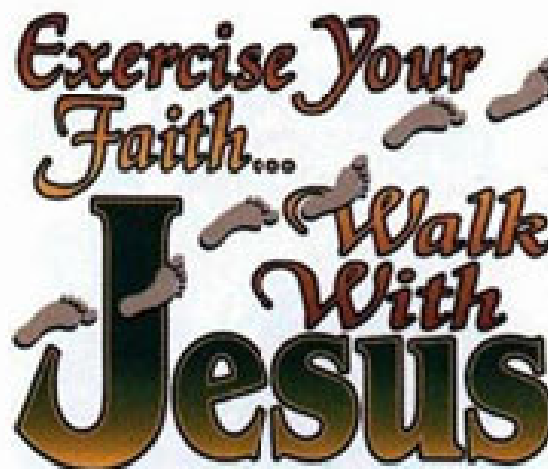
## WILL YOU EXERCISE YOUR FAITH? *(Committed to Faith)*
